Six Moral Foundations

CARE/HARM | caring for, protecting, preventing physical/mental harm

FAIRNESS/CHEATING | people getting what they deserve/have earned

LIBERTY/OPPRESSION | people being free to choose how to live; or more powerful forces denying someone their well-being

LOYALTY/BETRAYAL | prioritizing group needs; or if you're not with us, you're against us

AUTHORITY/SUBVERSION | protecting social order, respect for tradition / elders / authority

SANCTITY/DEGRADATION | protecting human dignity or what is sacred
